(AC3), to establish a management system **scalable IT**

infrastructure, agile and efficient that drives the development of the continuous cloud-edge. Also known as cloud-edge continuum, this paradigm consists of the perfect integration of data center systems and services (the cloud) and devices (the edge), something that will be key in smart cities, autonomous vehicles and all technological advances. related to the Internet of Things **Things (IoT)**.

The objective of the AC3 project is to design a framework and management system based on **AI and Machine Learning** that manages the life cycle of resources and applications, functioning as a cognitive system by distributing all IT capacity taking into account all its elements and components, regardless of where the data originates and is processed. Based on an open and trusted API, AC3 will simplify all aspects related to the federation of resources in the cloud-edge continuum, ensuring data interoperability and facilitating the development of a new generation of applications.

With total European funding of 5,9 million, AC3 is a project that is part of Horizon Europe, the research and innovation framework program for the period 2021 -2027. It is directed from the Greek research center **Industrial Systems Institute/Athena Research Center** and coordinated by **Christos Verikoukis**, under the technical direction of Adlen Ksentini, from the French entity EURECOM. In addition to Arsys, IONOS, ISI-Athena RIC and EURECOM, the AC3 consortium also includes, among others, different European companies and institutions, such as EURECOM, IBM, Cloud Software Group, Red Hat, Spark Works, UBITECH, Fingletek, Iquadrat Informática, the Complutense University of Madrid and the University of Piraeus, which provide extensive experience and multidisciplinary knowledge to achieve the ambitious objectives of the AC3 project.

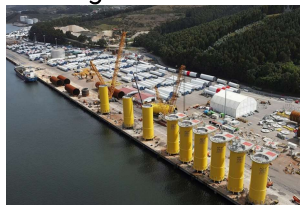

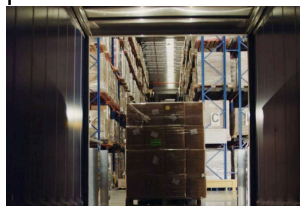
